But if fireworks are legal where you live and you decide to set them off on your own be sure to follow these important safety tips:

- ★ Never allow children to play with or ignite fireworks.
- ★ Read and follow all warnings and instructions.
- ★ Be sure other people are out of range before lighting fireworks.
- ★ Only light fireworks on a smooth, flat surface away from the house, dry leaves, and flammable materials. Never try to relight fireworks that have not fully functioned.
- ★ Keep a bucket of water in case of malfunction or fire.
